## Introduction skill: projects p.149

People all over the world have got pets. Books and films are full of cute, funny and clever pets. So what about a project on pets? There are many questions you can ask, for example:

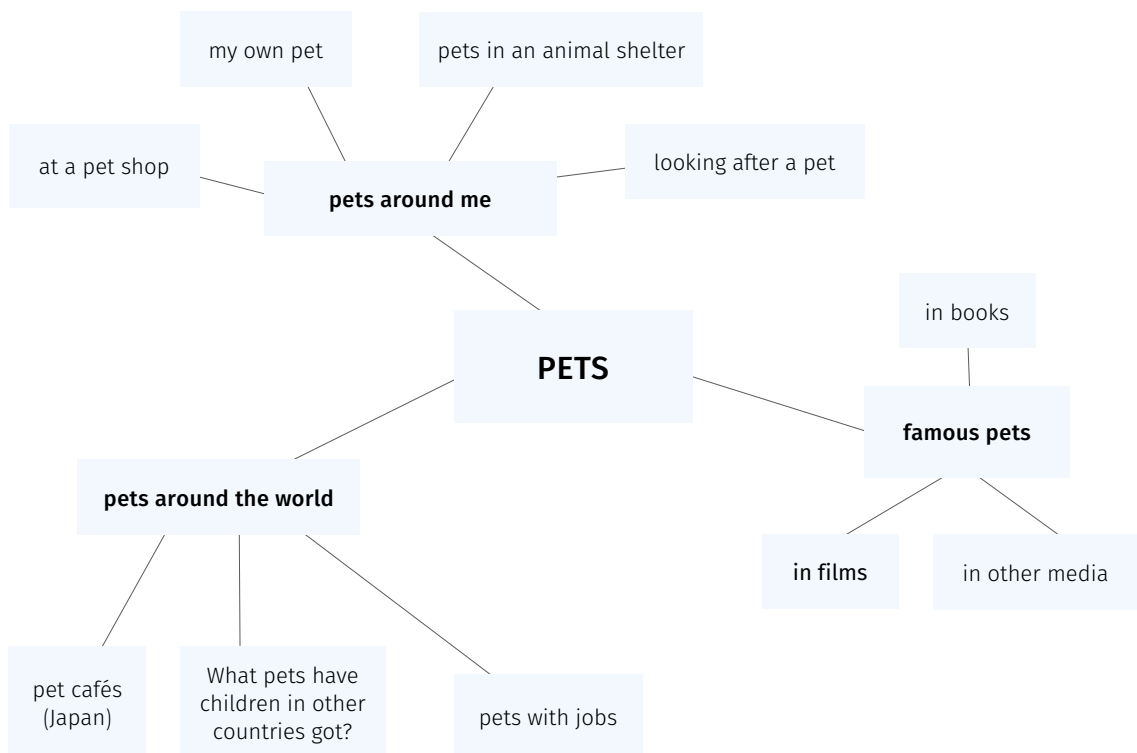
- What pets are there?

## Plan it

**1** In class, collect ideas for topics. You can make notes in a word web. Here is an example:



## 2 Now collect ideas about what you could create. For example:

- ▶ care sheets for different pets
- ▶ photo stories or short video clips
- ▶ a role play about a scene in a pet shop
- ▶ ...

### Care sheet for cats

- Give cats water and cat food.
- Don't give them sweets or chocolate!
- Don't give them milk!
- Clean ...

### Tip

You can make a class product, for example a brochure: every group creates one page and you put everything together in the end.



## 3 Now get together in small groups and make a detailed plan.

### Write down:

- ▶ what information you need
- ▶ how you can find information
- ▶ how you want to present your work
- ▶ what material you need for your project work (for example: computer, paper, glue, ...)
- ▶ who does what and when

### Tip

When you as a group have a plan about what to do and how to present your work, you can ask your classmates from other groups for feedback on your plan.

And ... action! Do research, interview people, collect pictures, write texts, ... and create an interesting care sheet, poster, photo story, video clip, role play, ...

## Check it

## Present it

Present your work. You can ask your classmates for feedback after the presentation.
